The next chapter of data spaces will be written by leaders who move from sharing data to solving with it: powering industrial AI, unlocking new economic value and enabling data-driven innovation across companies and borders.

Ten years in, the foundations are built. Architecture, open standards and live deployments prove organizations can share data across boundaries while keeping control over it. The question is no longer whether it works, but what it is for and how to scale it.
